International Construction Contest "Modernization Of The Year - European Award" supports activities such as: saving past generation's properties and motivating to perfect new constructions in European countries. Furthermore, it tends to reward and promote construction projects distinguished by the special values and criteria.

What can be indicated in the contest:

- Modernized buildings/Objects
- New constructions
- Renovated cultural/historical heritages
- Revitalized outdoor objects

E.g. Roads and motorways, castles, churches, public utilities, industrial buildings, green areas, hotels, outdoor constructions, bridges, cultural/sport/health and recreation objects, railways, elevations and thermo-renovations, environmental protection, engineering works, ecological constructions, urban areas and complexes, Etc.

Application can be submitted by:

- Investors
- Architects
- Contractors
- Designers

In addition, objects can be indicated by local government, city mayors, institutions, associations, developers, anyone who cares about the good of the region and the achievements of the community.

EUROPEAN AWARD

Previous edition included 460 constructions, 62 buildings - 3 of them were buildings from Central and Eastern Europe.

The Final part of the Contest is an Award Presentation Ceremony in the **Royal Castle in Warsaw**, where the winners are honored with a gold statuette and the title "European Award".

The ceremony is accompanied by a concert of the Song and Dance Ensemble "Śląsk".

The first European Award was presented to engineering, construction company JSV "Belzarubezhstroy", for modernization of the cement-bonded factory in Krichev, Belarus.
